DIVE REPORT:

Hull:

Bottom Paint percentage is approximately 60%, fair antifouling properties left. Some side areas with visible wear.

Hull with no issues or damages to report.

Intakes and thru-hulls all in perfect working condition, clean and clear, A/C intake was clogged with plastic bags, after cleaning suction was detected, the system should be internally descaled and flushed to assure full water flow.

No visible blisters, scratches or soft spots on the hull.

Running Gear:

Propellers with no visible damage, some propspeed coating still left on both propellers, Struts with almost no paint left and Shaft with propspeed coating, no issues or visible damages to report, Cutless Bearings with no visible wear, propellers felt normally slightly tight when turned.

No visible corrosion observed.

Anodes:

Propnut anodes active: Starboard side approximately <20% left. Portside anode completely depleted. Need urgent replacement.

Strut Anodes: Approximately 70% left.

Transom Anodes: active, port side: approximately 80% left, Starboard side approximately 60% left

Recommendation: Anodes should be replaced at approximately 50% surface left.

All underwater lights were fully functional.

No damages or issues to report overall.
